Fort Griswold, located in Groton, CT, is not only a local landmark but what should be recognized as a national treasure. The Battle of Fort Griswold took place on 9/6/1781 during the American Revolutionary war and has had many popular stories passed down from generations, but what if some of those claims aren't all that accurate?
