SUMMER READING

Summer Reading Logs will be available starting June 21st.

The goal of summer reading is to encourage kids to read consistently and to find books they enjoy! For every week a child reads 5 days or more, they can be entered into the weekly prize drawing. You can enter the prize raffle by bringing your reading log into the library and showing it to the staff member at the desk. We will draw one winner per week. Contact information will be needed to enter the weekly raffle. We encourage families to have a conversation about the amount of time read that will count as a day of reading for each child. A general starting place is 20 minutes a day, but all kids are different! Listening to an audiobook, being read to, or reading any sort of fiction/non-fiction/graphic novel all count towards the reading log. Trying different types of books is always a plus!
