

**The goal of summer reading is to encourage kids to read consistently throughout the summer and to find books they enjoy!**

We encourage families to have a conversation about the amount of time read that will count as a day of reading for each child. A general starting place is **20** minutes a day, but everyone is different. For new readers, reading to themselves for less time may be just right. For a strong reader who is already reading most days, half an hour or more could be a good goal. Choose a time that feels right for your child and family, and feel free to adjust it throughout the summer as needed!

Listening to an audiobook, being read to, or reading any type of fiction/non-fiction/graphic novel all count toward the reading log. Trying different types of books is always a plus!

For every week that you read 5 days or more, you can be entered in the weekly raffle to win a prize.  
**We will have one prize winner per week.**

You can enter the prize raffle by bringing your reading log into the library and showing it to the staff member at the children's desk, sending us a photo, or calling the library.

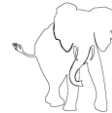
