Join us for a special story time all about the library! We will read stories, sing songs and make a book. No registration is required.

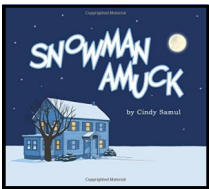
#### 12:00 pm - 2:00 pm: R.E.A.D. Therapy Dogs
